Directions to 15 Deep Lane
From Southern State Parkway:
Take exit 28 South, Wantagh Avenue. Go
to the first light and make a right turn onto
Duckpond Drive. Make the first left onto
Duckpond Drive East. Then go four blocks to
Deep Lane and make a right. 15 Deep Lane is
on your right.

From Sunrise Highway:
Turn onto Wantagh Avenue heading north
and go approximately two miles to Duckpond
Drive. Make a left turn. Make the first left
onto Duckpond Drive East. Then go four blocks
to Deep Lane and make a right. 15 Deep Lane
is on your right.
